Important Reminders:

- Complete and kmail a "Family Vacation Event" Form if your family has travel plans for more than 2 days.
 After making contact with your homeroom teacher, you will mark those dates as vacation days in the OLS, so they do not appear as missing days.
- Students are expected to reach 100% mastery in each course with 1098 hours of attendance by June 6, 2013.
- Students are expected to log a minimum of 6 hours attendance per day. Note: If your student has mastered all required lessons on a given day and has not reached the minimum 6 hours, please instruct them to move on to the next day's lessons until they have met the daily attendance requirement (6 hrs. per day/30 hrs. per week)
- Students are required to log into each OLS course on Pupil Count Days: Oct. 2nd and Feb 12th. Learning Coaches will sign a compliancy form on each of these days.
- Students in grades 3-9 are required to participate in MEAP testing in October and will travel to select testing locations in Michigan. Failure to participate in MEAP testing will result in Withdrawal from MVCA.
- Students are required to complete weekly Math and ELA blue ribbon assessments in Study Island. They will attend Class Connect Remediation sessions when needed. Failure to participate in Study Island assessments can result in Withdrawal from MVCA.
- Students in grades K-12 are required to complete Scantron Performance Series Testing and NWEA Testing
 online in the Fall and Spring. Failure to participate in Scantron and NWEA testing can result in Withdrawal
 from MVCA.
